LLS has committed to:

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to 22 tCO2e by 2027. This is a reduction of 50%.

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented in 2024.

LLS UK has signed up to the SME Climate Hub and committed to decrease carbon emissions by 2027, the internal Social Value committee meets monthly to discuss and drive various initiatives to achieve this.

Accreditation to ISO 14001 was continued in August 2024.

Update to waste management – working with building management company to ensure the Simpler Recycling framework is followed as part of a drive to ensure the building is fully compliant before the deadline of the 31st March 2025.
